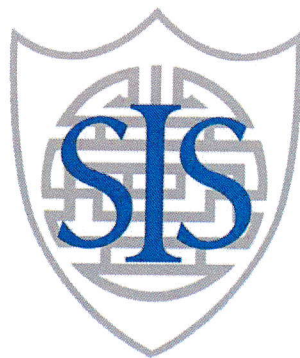

It has been a delight to have Aiden in Sapphire class this term. He is a happy little boy who loves coming to school. Aiden always has confidence to speak to adults and enjoys carrying out small tasks within the classroom. He loves exploring the learning environment and demonstrates friendly behaviour with his peers. Aiden is able to follow directions either in adult led sessions or circle time. He has started to listen more attentively and participates with his peers sharing his wonderful ideas and always trying his best. Aiden is able to understand 'how' and 'why' questions and he uses his spoken English to communicate with both adults and his peers. Aiden travels with confidence and can jump off an object and land appropriately. Aiden is still exploring mark making and has yet to show preference for a dominant hand, using both using a whole hand palmar grip. He is able to form the letters of his name so that they are easily identifiable. Aiden always has lots of creative ideas and he displays this within his learning and is willing to have a go at all activities presented to him.

Aiden can hear and say the initial sound in words and this is something we continue to work on. Aiden never gives up and he always keeps trying no matter how tricky the task at hand may be. Aiden loves books and he is often in the book corner looking at the selection of books, he always handles them with care. Aiden enjoys our mathematics lessons and he can recognise numerals 1-15 and count up to that number as well. He is able to record his findings with marks he can explain and interpret. He also enjoys practical activities and problem solving with numbers. He always has his own ideas during problem solving activities and enjoys sharing his findings with everyone in the class. He likes shapes and is able to name 3D and 2D shapes. Aiden likes technology and can complete a simple programme on a

computer. Aiden has started to explore the role-play area more in class and enjoys sharing and developing his ideas with his peers and choosing ways to do things.
